

BAR RATES JUDICIAL CANDIDATES

The Beaver County Bar Association recently conducted a plebiscite, or poll, of its regular members to determine how they would rate the judicial candidates that are seeking the one Beaver County judgeship post that will be selected by the Primary Election of May, 2019 and the General Election of November, 2019. The Association conducts this evaluation because it feels that the public would like to know how the regular members of the Association, who work more closely with the candidates as fellow lawyers than anyone else, and who have a working knowledge of their legal abilities, would rate the fitness of those candidates to serve as a judge.

Candidate Laura J. Tocci was rated HIGHLY RECOMMENDED by more than 50% of the Bar's regular membership who submitted ballots. The complete voting results as to all candidates are as follows:
